Next Sunday, February 5th is our "First Sunday Potluck." This is quality fellowship time. Bring something to share — your self and a few of your valuable minutes is the only required gift.

Also next Sunday at CEC we will transfer the Feast of our Lord's Presentation in the Temple to our Sunday worship. This celebration is also known as "**Candlemas**". It is the last event in the Christmas cycle of the Church Year and signals a turn from the Church's attention to the mysteries of the Incarnation to the Lenten and Easter Cycle when we reflect and celebrate the mysteries of our redemption from sin and death. **Bring a candle for blessing — preferably a bottle candle or a pillar candle that you can put on your dinner table and light between now and Easter.**
